Budget is Approved - NEW \$\$\$ for VR program included



Senate & House Finalize Budget by Dawn A. Randolph, MPA April 1, 2015

This may be the best April 1st EVER!

The House and Senate voted the budget complete yesterday, March 31st, with the funding increase for GVRA-VR program approved.

\$900,000 state funds = Increase funds to assist training and employment support for Georgians with disabilities. This will pull down \$3,600,000 federal funds for a total \$4,500,000 You can reference the Final Bill Conference Committee FY 2016 on page 129 line 197.7. (also shown below in this email) Honestly I can't stop looking at the budget line, all our hard work over the past three years really paid off! Thank you for taking the time each step of the way to make a call, visit with a legislator, collect data and share stories.
