GATES member organizations provide a critical service to the Georgia Vocational Rehabilitation Agency through contracts with the Vocational Rehabilitation Division. While the state budget has fully recovered from the Great Recession, Georgia has not fully invested state funds to match the total amount of federal 110 allocation available to Georgia. With your investment and other matching funds we can fully fund Vocational Rehabilitation to put more Georgians with disabilities to work.
