IPSE Day at the Capitol Cancelled/Session Schedule requires big Budget Break

Session adjourned until Tuesday, Feb 18th so the IPSE day at the Capitol is cancelled for today/Thursday Feb 6th. However, Mental Health Day at the Capitol is still on at the Freight Depot from 8am to noon this Friday, Feb 7th.

The House and Senate have agreed to take the next eight business days off to tackle the amended budget. SR 712 sets the calendar showing the General Assembly meeting full weeks from Feb 18th to March 12th.

Crossover day is set for March 12th, which will be the 28th day. Technically the session could end March 31st but that is unlikely to happen. The leadership has not agreed on the schedule for the final 12 days of the session yet and likely won't until March.
